

Long Service Awards – Guidelines

Long Service Award - minimum 25 years service but not to have reached 50 years

Recipient will receive a framed **Certificate of Service**, where applicable

Gold Award – 50 years + service

Recipient will receive a framed **Diploma of Honour** and an engraved **50 year Long Service Medal**

Diamond Award – 60 years + service

Recipient will receive a framed **Diamond Certificate of Service** and an engraved **60 year Long Service Medal**

Platinum Award – 70 years + service

Recipient will receive a framed **Platinum Certificate of Service** and an engraved **70 years Long Service Medal**

The NWABBA Executive will attempt to provide an Officer of the Association to make the presentation if required.

We accept years of service in any armed forces as part of the service. School Bands and Scouting type organisation bands may make up part of the service. Whilst the recipient must be a member of one of our member bands when the application is made, not all the service has to be with a band which is a member of the NWABBA.

Please make any applications at least one month prior to the date you wish them to be presented for the Executive to approve the applications and for the items to be prepared.
