RULES

Interpretation of the rules shall be the prerogative of the Contest Organisers and the Executive Committee of the NWABBA.

Each band to consist of up to 45 players a full list of players with their date of birth to be handed in upon arrival. We recognise that many youth band players are members of more than one band and this is acceptable. In line with the adult contest there is scope for borrowed players also.

The contest will be pre drawn and bands advised of their arrival, warm up and playing time.

An unmarked Original or official photocopied scores to be presented on arrival.

Band will need to provide 2 copies of the pieces in playing order (one for the adjudicator and one for the compere)

Open adjudication. Placings only will be awarded (no points).

Objections and complaints must be put in writing within 14 days of the contest and accompanied by a deposit of £30, which will be refunded if the complaint is upheld.

Prize monies will be withheld for 14 days pending objections. Trophies will be designed for the contest and can be kept by the prize winners

The contest management will not accept responsibility for any expenses incurred by bands or their members in connection with the contest, unless previously agreed in writing by the management.
